

Expanded SUD Treatment



Expanded SUD Treatment

Primary Goal: ensure coverage for the full continuum of SUD treatment

- <u>Expand</u> coverage for **inpatient services** to IMD settings to primarily treat opioid use disorder or other SUD
 - February 2018
- <u>Create</u> coverage for **residential services** (per diem payment)
 - March 2018
- <u>Expand</u> coverage for addiction recovery management services
 - Later in 2018



Certification Standards



Certification Standards

Primary Goal: align Indiana's addiction providers with the American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM) standards of care

- <u>Create</u> ASAM-level designation process for residential providers
 - February 2018
- <u>Expand</u> Indiana Administrative Code (IAC) certification standards with ASAM
 - Later in 2018



Designation Process

• <u>DMHA Website</u>

- 1. Obtain Appropriate Certifications from DMHA
- 2. Obtain ASAM Designation (offering 3.1 or 3.5 level services)
- Enroll/Add Provider Type and Specialty (Type 35, Specialty 836)



Assessment Standards



Assessment Standards

Primary Goal: ensure that providers and Indiana Medicaid are using the same assessment tools to ensure the most appropriate level of care

- <u>Creating (or updating)</u> a standard addiction assessment tool that incorporates all six dimensions of multidimensional assessment from ASAM
 - Summer/Fall 2018
