3. Behavioral Disorder

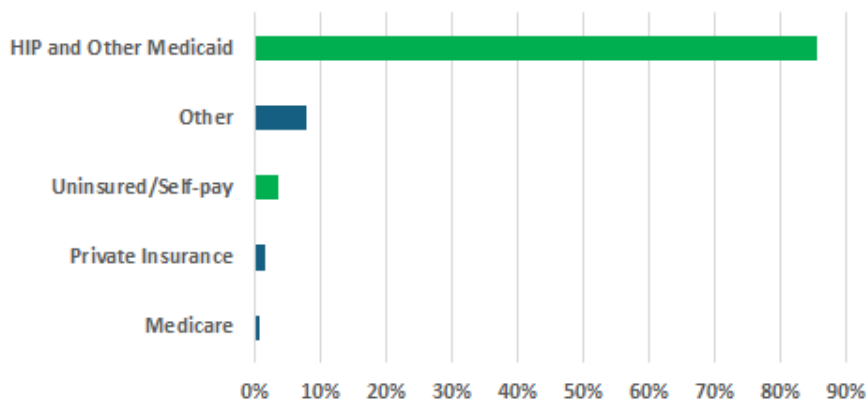
Top 3 Primary Diagnoses - Adults:
