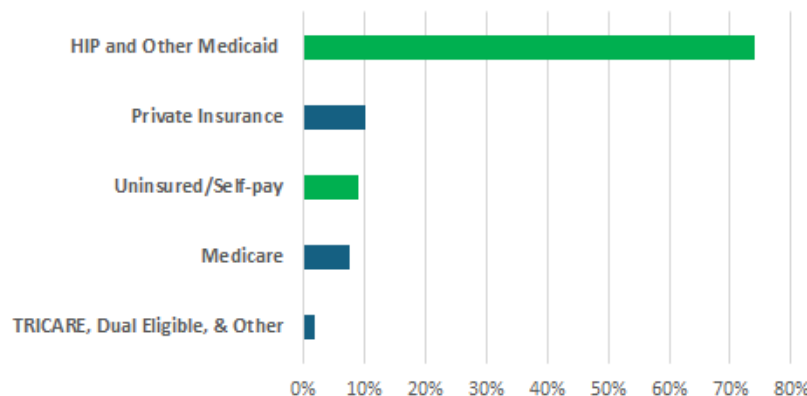
Top 3 Primary Diagnoses - Adults:
