New Program and Partnership Highlights:

- Northeastern Center Cares, a 24/7 crisis receiving and stabilization unit. Located in Auburn, NEC Cares provides short-term observation in a home-like setting for anyone experiencing a mental health or substance use disorder crisis
- Northeastern Center completed its triennial Community Health Needs Assessment in early 2024, collecting information from multiple sources, including community members. The target areas identified as priorities for the next three years were substance/alcohol abuse, child abuse/neglect, and suicide reduction/education

3. Anxiety Disorder

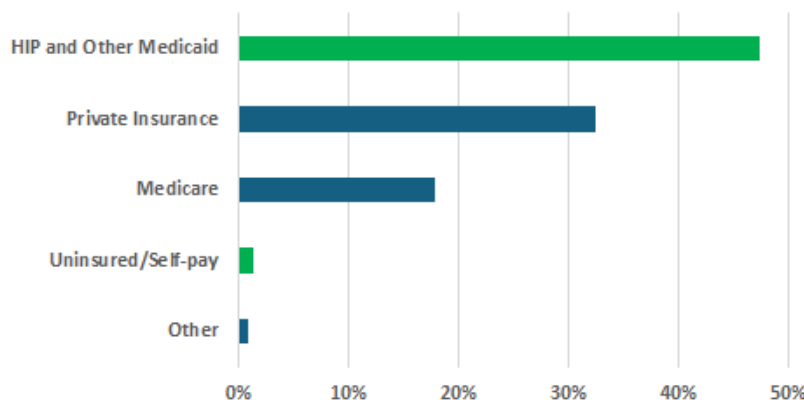
Top 3 Primary Diagnoses - Adults:
