- Caring Recovery Opioid Treatment Program relocated and opened May 2024, expanded access to treatment for opioid use disorder

3. Generalized Anxiety Disorder

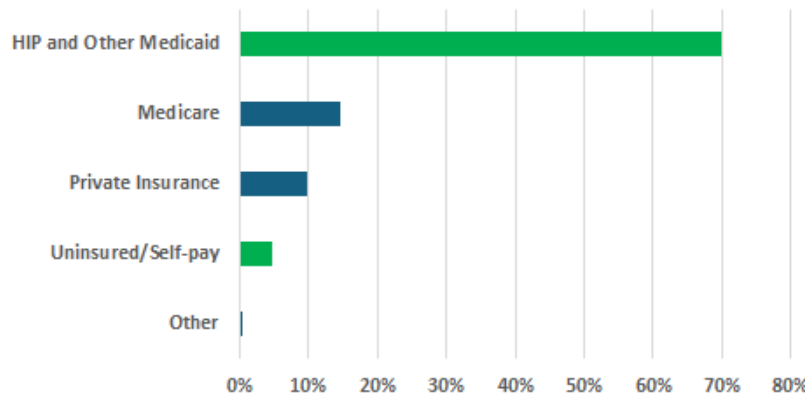
Top 3 Primary Diagnoses - Adults:
